Qualification Description

This qualification reflects the skills and knowledge required to deliver training and assessment services usually within aviation Registered Training Organisations (RTOs) or flight training organisations.

This qualification is preparation for those engaged in the delivery of training and assessment of competence in an aviation workplace context, as a component of a structured vocational education and training (VET) program.

Flight instruction duties include applying technical and non-technical aviation and vocational skills and knowledge to a wide range of learners, operating conditions and aviation environments.

Individuals working at this level will apply knowledge and skills to demonstrate autonomy, judgement and defined responsibility in known or changing contexts within broad but established parameters.

Job roles include:

- Grade 3 Training Endorsement
- Qualified Flying Instructor - Military

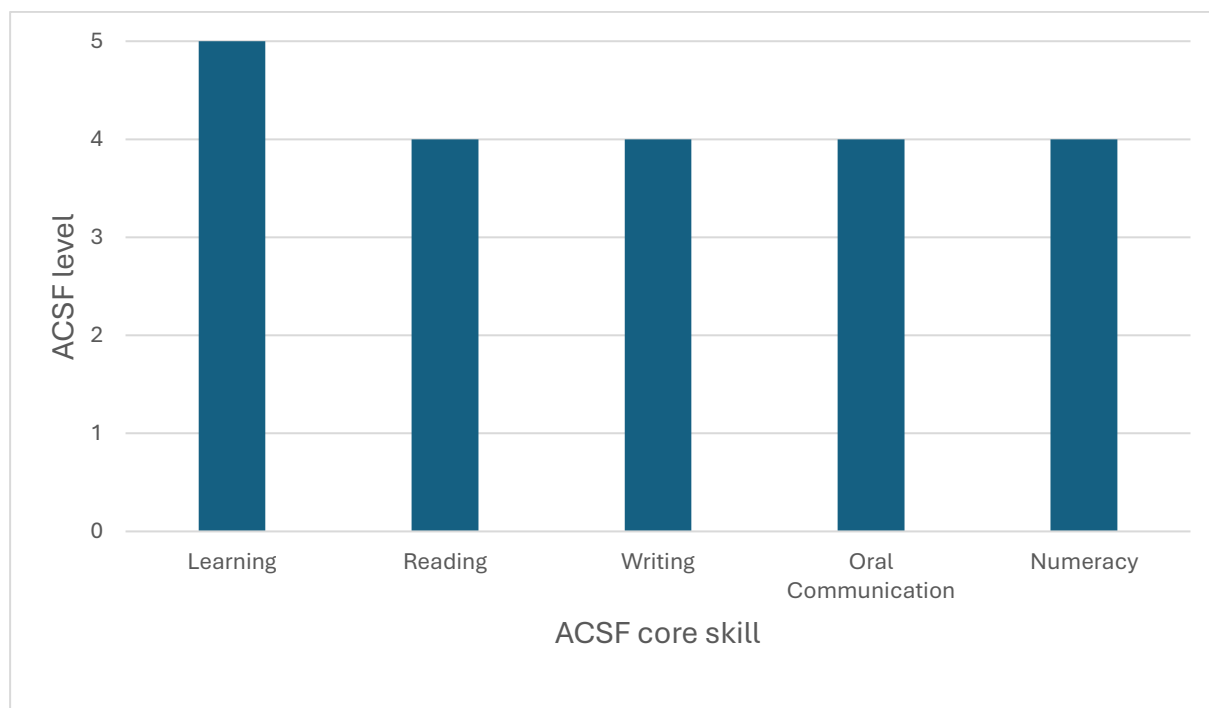
Licensing/Regulatory Information

This qualification meets some of the requirements for certification as a flight instructor by the Civil Aviation Safety Authority (CASA) as directed by Civil Aviation Safety Regulation (CASR) Part 61 Flight crew licensing.

People seeking certification should check these requirements with CASA.

Commercial or military pilot entrants to this qualification must meet CASA or Defence Aviation requirements for certification and/or flight hour requirements or be able to demonstrate equivalent competence.

Up to 2 of the elective units may be selected from any relevant nationally endorsed Training Package. The elective units must contribute to the vocational outcomes of the qualification.
