Qualification Description

This is a qualification for those engaged in specialist driving operations in the transport and logistics industry.

It includes specialisations for:

- Chemical and Fuel Tanker
- Gas Tanker
- Bitumen Tanker
- Heavy Vehicle Recovery.

Job roles and titles vary across different sectors. Possible job titles relevant to this qualification include:

- bitumen tanker driver
- chemical tanker driver
- fuel tanker driver
- heavy vehicle recovery driver
- gas tanker driver
- transport supervisor

Individuals with this qualification perform a broad range of technical and skilled operations related to driving often involving dangerous goods, including evaluating and responding to a variety of environmental and site conditions. They will have skills and knowledge that are transferrable across a range of driving job roles. They apply discretion and judgement when selecting equipment, services or contingency measures. They may also be responsible for coordinating the work of others.

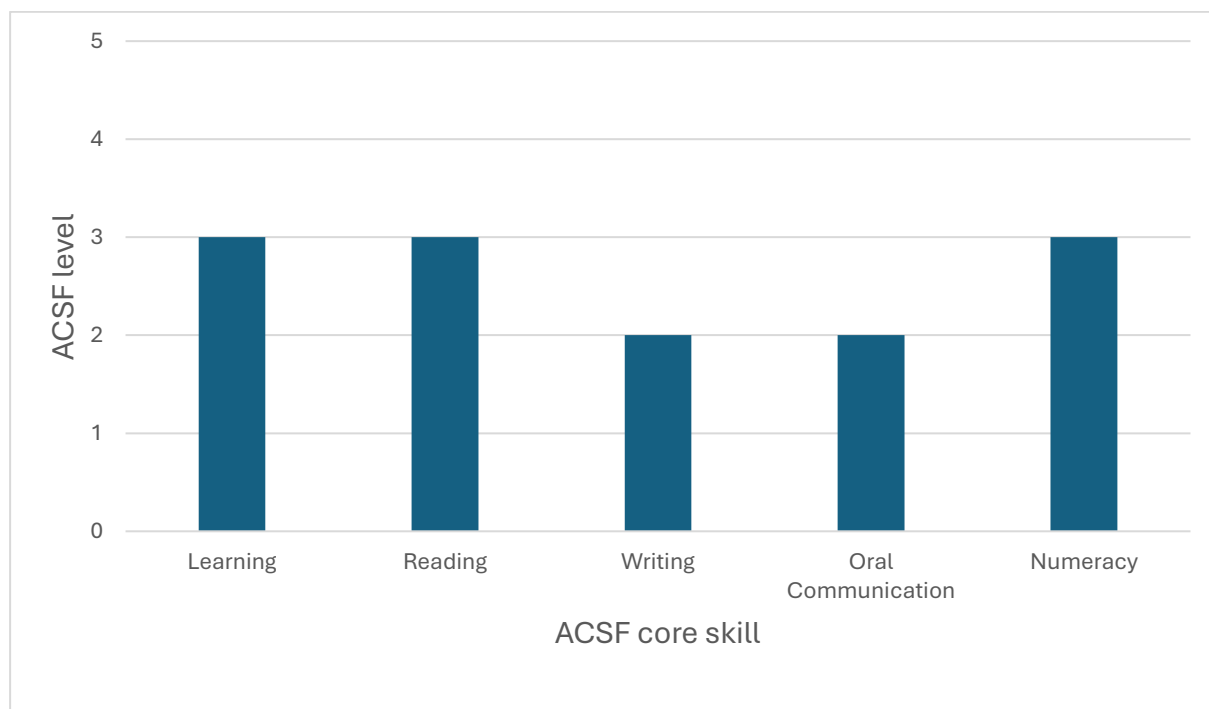
